1. FIXED ASSETS AND DEPRECIATION

LAND AND RESIDENCE

In 2014, the Refuge purchased property at 7877 Skimikin Road. This property is mortgaged by the Salmon Arm Savings and Credit Union.

2. SHORT-TERM INVESTMENT

The charity has been gifted a series of securities. These are invested through the CIBC Investor's Edge and are available for specific uses such as fencing and the future infirmary.

3. MORTGAGE PAYABLE

Mortgage is due to the Salmon Arm Savings and Credit Union and is secured by the property and residence at 7877 Skimikin Road. Payments are \$731 per week including principal and interest (\$3,351 per month in 2016).

4. MEMBER ADVANCE

In 2017, the founding members advanced operating funds and capital asset funds to the Charity to renovate the Donkey Visitor Center and Shoppe. Those funds have not been reimbursed.. The member advance has no interest component and will be repaid at a manageable monthly rate with interest.
