NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS December 31, 2013 (Unaudited - See Notice to Reader)

1. FIXED ASSETS AND DEPRECIATION

BARN CONSTRUCTION COSTS

Max Barn - constructed in 2011

The capitalized portion of the cost of the barn includes only the building itself and the footings. The costs to excavate the land and portable materials such as gates and railings have been expensed.

Sady/Maria Barn Overhang- constructed in 2012

All costs associated with the construction of the overhang for the main barn have been capitalized.

The majority of the funding for this construction was from a grant from the Vancouver Foundation.

EQUIPMENT

In 2013, the Refuge purchased a small commercial grade tractor. Depreciation on all equipment has been calculated and expensed at 20%.

2. GAMING GRANTS

In early 2013, the Refuge successfully applied for the 2014 BC Gaming Grant, requesting funds to cover the costs of caring for the donkeys. These costs included animal care, farm and property care including the lease, and wages for farm staff. The grant money was received in November 2013. Although this grant can be utilized upon receipt, only a small portion of this grant was used to pay for animal care in 2013. The balance of the grant monies received has been set up as deferred receipts to properly reflect the fiscal activities of 2014.

3. MEMBER ADVANCE

In 2012 and 2013, the founding members advanced the unpaid portion of the lease to the Society as well as expenses from 2012 that were not reimbursed in 2013. This advance has no interest component and no set terms of repayment.

4. RESTRICTED MEMBERS' EQUITY

In anticipation of the purchase of a farm for the Donkey Refuge, we have received a donation of \$10,000 which is to be used toward the purchase of the farm or construction of the barns and buildings.
